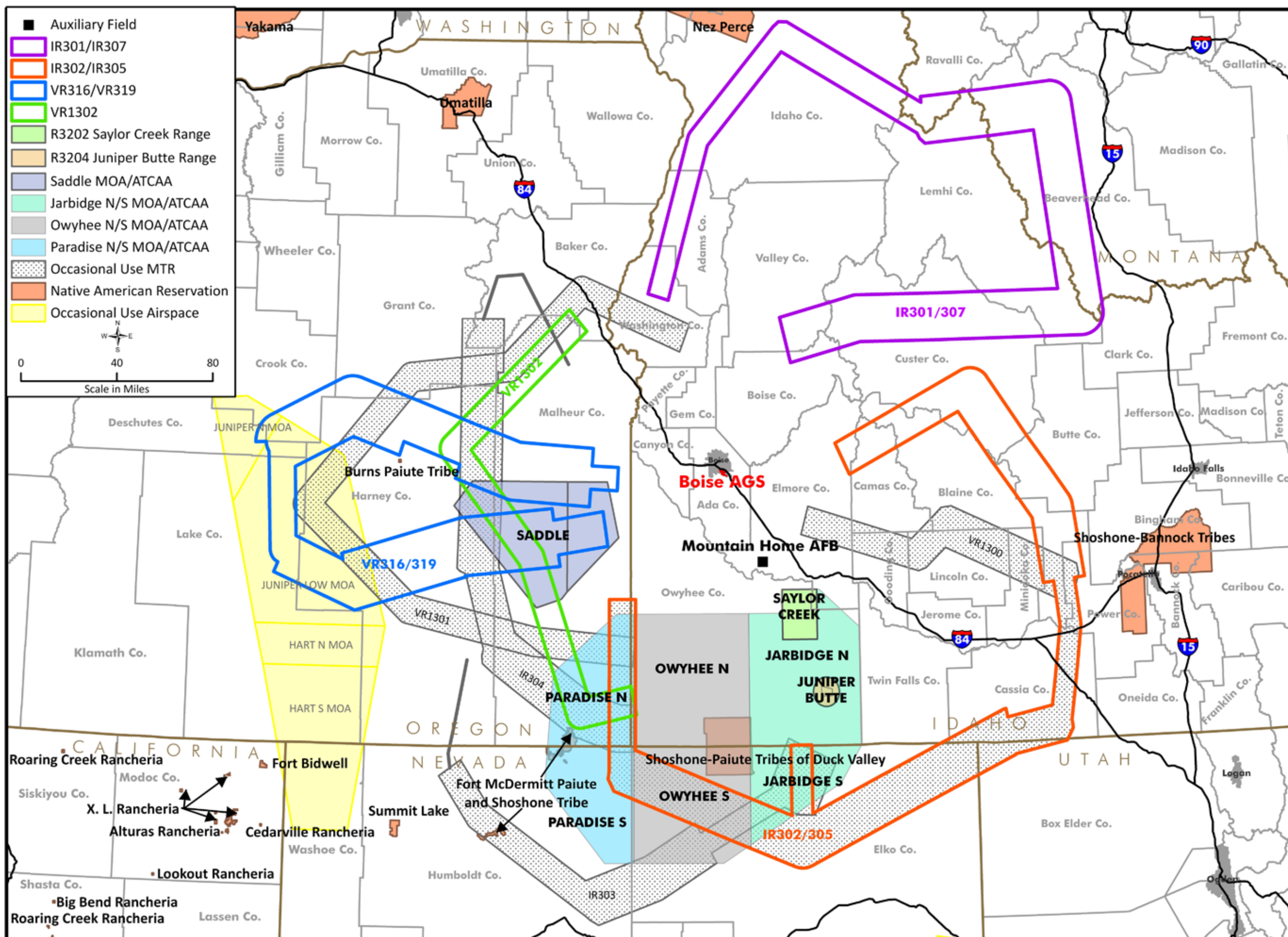
### BOISE AIR TERMINAL AIRPORT AIR GUARD STATION (GOWEN FIELD)



Boise Air Terminal Airport Air Guard Station (AGS) is one of four alternative installations analyzed in the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for establishment of a Pilot Training Center and associated basing of F-35A training aircraft.

#### Boise AGS:

- Is home to the 124th Fighter Wing of the Idaho Air National Guard and includes components of the Army National Guard.
- Supports the 124th Fighter Wing's flying unit, the 190th Fighter Squadron.
- Consists of 1,400 full- and part-time Airmen.
- Uses training airspace associated with the Mountain Home Range Complex.
- Consists of an exclusive-use military lease, totaling 576 acres of land, and a joint-use agreement between the City and the military, totaling 1,500 acres of land.
- Covers the southern half of the Boise Air Terminal Airport and is operated as a joint military/civilian facility.
